Our goal is to provide personalized, step by step guidance. If your tax problem meets our criteria, we'll assign a Case Advocate to work directly with you.

TAS's Problem Solving Day event will be held at the Michael Franck Building, 306 Townsend St, Lansing MI 48933 on May 6, 2019 from 9:00 am to 3:00pm.

The Taxpayer Advocate Service will be joining the Alvin Storrs LITC clinicians, the State of Michigan Taxpayer Advocate, IRS Counsel and other IRS employees. No appointments are necessary for this session.

The Taxpayer Advocate Service is an **independent** organization within the Internal Revenue Service. TAS helps taxpayers resolve tax problems, recommends changes to prevent future tax problems, and protects taxpayer rights. TAS's **services are free** to taxpayers who are:

- Experiencing a financial hardship or having financial difficulties because of a tax problem;
- Trying, but haven't been able to resolve an IRS tax problem; or
- Believing an IRS system or procedure isn't working.
