

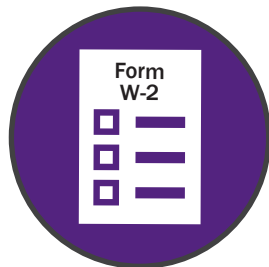
Avoid Refund Delays

Follow these tips to help prevent common issues.



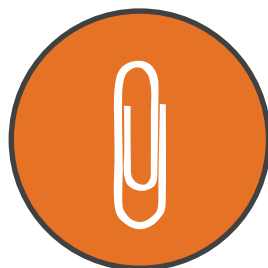
Use your Form W-2, not your pay stub, to verify your income.

Your employer has until January 31 to issue your W-2, and you should wait to receive it before you file.



Double check that your information is correct for yourself and your dependents.

Check name spellings, Social Security numbers, dates of birth, addresses, and your bank account information.



Attach all forms and schedules before you submit your return.

Don't forget your W-2s, 1099s, and other attachments.



You need a 1098T from an educational institution to claim education expenses.

Schools have until January 31 to mail this form.



Be aware of tax software that imports prior year data automatically.

Make sure you're using current tax year data to avoid mistakes.
