The Taxpayer Advocate Service (TAS) will be available to assist individual and practitioners in person with personal or client tax problems they have not been able to resolve with the IRS. Our goal is to provide one to one guidance, direction on next steps, and case building ideas so you can help your clients. If your or your client's problem(s) meets our criteria, we'll assign a Case Advocate to work with you to resolve the issue(s).

This event will be held at the Hampton Inn on Perdido Beach Boulevard in Orange Beach, Alabama. TAS will be available to assist and you don't need an appointment. If you are a practitioner, please bring your client's tax specific information. In addition, you must have a Power of Attorney (POA) on record with the IRS or bring the completed and signed POA with you, so TAS can access individual accounts. If you don't have a POA, TAS may still be able to assist you with general information and questions.

The Taxpayer Advocate Service is an **independent** organization within the Internal Revenue Service that helps taxpayers and protects taxpayer rights. We help taxpayers whose problems with the IRS are causing financial difficulties, who've tried but haven't been able to resolve their problems with the IRS, or believe an IRS system or procedure isn't working as it should. And our service is **free**.
