If you are not a CPA, Enrolled Agent, or licensed attorney, you will likely need to use the Form 8821. Please bring a signed copy of the form with you to the event. Appointments will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. TAS will be located in the hallway right outside the main classrooms at Room 352.

TAS is an **independent** organization within the IRS. TAS helps taxpayers resolve tax problems, recommends changes to prevent future tax problems, and protects taxpayer rights. TAS's **services are free** to taxpayers who are:

- Experiencing a financial hardship or having financial difficulties because of a tax problem;
- Trying, but haven't been able to resolve an IRS tax problem; or
- Believing an IRS system or procedure isn't working.
