The TAS offices from Trenton, NJ, as well as Manhattan and Brooklyn, NY will be at the event. Please bring with you the information you'd like to discuss such as copies of tax returns, letters and notices from the IRS, and any related records. If you need assistance and are unable to attend this event, you can call TAS at 1-877-777-4778. Also, the TAS will be sharing information on TAS careers. TAS is hiring in positions such as customer service, accounting, tax law, human resources, communications, finance, technology and more.
